To amend the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act to provide local areas more flexibility in the use of funds for incumbent workforce training programs.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Professional Growth
- 5 and Retention Act".

2	Section 134(d)(4)(A) of the Workforce Innovation
3	and Opportunity Act (29 U.S.C. 3174(d)(4)(A)) is amend-
4	ed —
5	(1) in clause (i), by striking "20" and inserting
6	"40"; and
7	(2) by redesignating clauses (ii) and (iii) as
8	clauses (iii) and (iv), respectively, and inserting the
9	following:
10	"(ii) Increase in reservation of
11	FUNDS.—Notwithstanding clause (i), with
12	respect to a local area that had a rate of
13	unemployment of not more than 3 percent
14	for six or more months in the previous pro-
15	gram year, as determined by the State,
16	clause (i) shall be applied by substituting
17	'50 percent' for '40 percent'.".
